Bid Proposals will be received until 10:00 A.M. prevailing time on August 11, 2017 whereupon bids will be opened and read aloud for the following project:

Project No. 2016-1-CITF-021 – Public Safety and Emergency Equipment, Glassport Borough. Project consists of furnish and installation of two (2) emergency generators complete in place as fully specified.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder’s Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Glassport Borough and/or Steel Rivers Council of Governments in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will immediately enter into Agreement after the Notice of Award of the Contract and commence start of construction immediately thereafter.
