A certified check payable to the Township Of Hampton or a bid bond on the bid form executed by the Bidder and a surety company approved by the Owner, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid, shall be submitted with each bid, to guarantee the

Bidder's entrance into a contract if given the award. No bid bond shall be waived or returned because the Bidder has failed to or cannot comply with any requirements as set forth in the plans, specifications, or any applicable statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any applicable municipal ordinances. No bid may be withdrawn for sixty (60) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

All bidders must comply with the Federal requirements for Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L 88-352); with the President's Executive Order No. 11246; with EPA policy for increased use of minority consultants and construction contractors and the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, as amended.

Work under the aforementioned Contract is subject to the requirements of the "Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act" (1961 August 15, PL 987; P.S. 165) and subsequent amendments.
