A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, April 27, 2023, at the Big Sewickley Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 120 Wine Road, Sewickley, PA 15143 (GPS should use 1008 Big Sewickley Creek Road, Sewickley). Representatives of the OWNER and the ENGINEER will be available to discuss the Project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. ENGINEER will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda, as ENGINEER considers necessary in response to questions arising from the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

A certified check or bank draft, or a Bid Bond executed on the prescribed form by the Bidder and a Surety Company in the amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the Bid, shall be submitted with each Bid, to guarantee the Bidder entrance into a contract, if given the award. No Bid Bond shall be waived or returned because the Bidder failed to or cannot comply with any requirements as set forth in the Bidding Documents or any applicable statutes of the United States, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and/or all local ordinances.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the time of the opening of the bids.
