Sealed proposals will be received by the West Mifflin Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, until 12:00 P.M., September 25, 2023, prevailing time, at 1302 Lower Bull Run Road, West Mifflin, PA 15122. The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud September 25, 2023, at 1:00 P.M. prevailing time, at the West Mifflin Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority Building located at 1302 Lower Bull Run Road, West Mifflin, PA 15122.

Sanitary Sewer work under these Contracts covers the furnishing of all labor, material, plant, utilities, and services required for the construction of force main and gravity sewer along with by-pass pumping, demolition and abandonment of certain existing sanitary sewers and appurtenances. The project is located within the West Mifflin Borough. **Contract No. 2023-01A** Homestead Duquesne Road Sewer Realignment consists of construction of approximately 358 lineal feet of 8-inch PVC sewer and manholes. Work shall also include the modification exiting sanitary manholes and abandonment of the existing sewer. **Contract No. 2023-01B** Mid-City Pump Station Force Main Extension consists of construction of approximately 533 lineal feet of 8-inch PVC force main and manhole modification. **Contract No. 2023-01C** Curry Hollow Sanitary Sewer Realignment consists of construction of approximately 1550 lineal feet of 10-inch and 317 lineal feet of 15-inch PVC sewer and manholes. Work shall also include the modification exiting sanitary manholes and abandonment of the existing sewer.

Work on Contract No. 2023-01 C shall take place before PA Turnpike Mon/Fayette Expressway Project and must be completed before March 1, 2024.

Equipment and Services to be provided shall be according to the specifications which are on file at the office of KLH ENGINEERS, INC., 5173 Campbells Run Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15205, and at the Municipal Authority Office.

No bid bond shall be waived or returned because the Bidder has failed to or cannot comply with any requirements as set forth in the plans, specifications or any applicable statues of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any applicable ordinances.

SUCCESSFUL BIDDING BIDDER awarded this contract shall provide a performance surety in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.
