BID OPENING - Sealed bids shall be hand delivered or mailed to the Saegertown Area Sewer Authority. Mailed bids shall be delivered to the Saegertown Area Sewer Authority PO Box 334, Saegertown, PA 16433-0334 by 2:00 PM prevailing time, Wednesday, November 13th, 2024. Hand delivered bids shall be delivered to the SASA Wastewater Treatment Plant at 180 Park Avenue Ext. Saegertown PA, 16433 by 3:00 PM prevailing time, Wednesday, November 13th. Bids will be opened at the SASA Wastewater Treatment Plant at 3:00 PM prevailing time, Wednesday November 13th, 2024 at which time the sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the installation of Rotating Biological Contactor Equipment. Bid envelopes shall be labeled as follows:

No mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held, however, Contractors are required to visit the site prior to bid, and sign in at the plant, as proof of visiting the plant to understand site conditions and limitations.

No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the time of the opening of the bids.

Contractor shall submit an E-Verify Program Verification in compliance with the Public Works Employment Verification Act 127 of 2012.

BIDDER'S SURETY -- A certified check payable to the Saegertown Area Sewer Authority or a bid bond on the bid form executed by the Bidder and a surety company approved by the OWNER, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of bid, must be submitted with each bid or bids will be considered nonresponsive and immediately rejected.

SUCCESSFUL BIDDING BIDDER awarded this contract shall provide a performance surety in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER -- the Saegertown Area Sewer Authority fully complies with the provisions of this act. All qualified bidders are invited to submit a proposal.

This agreement is for services related to a project that is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA"), Pub. L. 177-58. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States, as further outlined by the Office of Management and Budget's Memorandum M-22-11, Initial Implementation Guidance on Application of Buy America Preference in Federal Financial Assistance Programs for Infrastructure, April 18, 2022.
