Economy Borough Municipal Authority (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

**Conway Pump Station Improvements**  
**Contract Nos. 2025-01A, 2025-01B**

Sealed bids for the construction of the Project will be received at Economy Borough Municipal Authority located at 2860 Conway Wallrose Road, Baden, PA 15005, until Wednesday, January 15, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The furnishing of all labor, material, plant, utilities, and services required for the construction of the Conway Pump Station upgrades. The project generally consists of upgrading EBMA’s existing Conway Pump station with new pumps, piping, electrical and monitoring equipment.

Owner anticipates that the Project’s total bid price will be approximately \$470,000.00 for Contract 2025-01A and \$216,000.00 for Contract No. 2025-01B. The Project has an expected duration of three hundred sixty-five (365) days.

Prospective Bidders may obtain or examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. local time, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bidding Documents may be purchased from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above for \$200. Cost does not include shipping charges. Upon Issuing Office’s receipt of payment, printed Bidding

Documents or electronic documents on compact disk will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method chosen.

**Instructions to Bidders.**

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

Attention is called to the fact that prevailing minimum wage rates as determined by the Secretary of the Department of Labor and Industry must be paid by the Contractors on this project and that employees and applicants for employment shall not be discriminated against because of their race, age, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap. Each contractor is required to meet the requirements of Public Works Employment Verification Act, Act 127 of 2012.

Any and all steel products used or supplied in the performance of the contract or any subcontracts shall be from steel made in the United States.

The Owner hereby reserves the right, which is understood and agreed to by all bidders, to refuse and reject any or all bids submitted, and also reserves the right to waive any informality in bids received.

Except as otherwise provided by law, no bidder may withdraw its bid for sixty (60) days after the Bid Due Date, unless the contract award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or the award of a grant or grants, in which case the Bids shall remain open to acceptance and shall be irrevocable for a period of sixty (60) after the Bid Due Date.

This agreement is for services related to a project that is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA"), Pub. L. 177-58. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States, as further outlined by the Office of Management and Budget's Memorandum M-22-11, Initial Implementation Guidance on Application of Buy America Preference in Federal Financial Assistance Programs for Infrastructure, April 18, 2022.

This project was financed in part by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting through the Commonwealth Financing Authority.
