

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Richland Township Municipal Authority, of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, is seeking sealed proposals online via the PennBid Program until Tuesday, April 15, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. for Contract No. 2025-01 - Chessrown Ave & Community Center Drive Waterline Replacement Project. The bid opening shall be conducted virtually. Bidders can contact the Authority for a link.

No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the time of the opening of the bids.

Contractor shall submit an E-Verify Program Verification in compliance with the Public Works Employment Verification Act 127 of 2012.

BIDDER'S SURETY -- A certified check payable to Richland Township Municipal Authority or a bid bond on the bid form executed by the Bidder and a surety company approved by the OWNER, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of bid, must be submitted with each bid or bids will be considered nonresponsive and immediately rejected.

Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 -1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran-Owned Small Businesses.

SUCCESSFUL BIDDER awarded this contract shall provide a performance surety in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.
