A certified bond payable to the North Huntingdon Township Municipal Authority or a bid bond on the bid form executed by the Bidder and a surety company approved by the OWNER, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of bid, must be submitted with each bid or bids will be considered nonresponsive and immediately rejected. No bid bond shall be waived or returned because the Bidder has failed to or cannot comply with any requirements as set forth in the plans, specifications or any applicable statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any applicable ordinances. No bid may be withdrawn for (60) sixty days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

Contractor shall submit prior to contract award an E-Verify Program Verification in compliance with the Public Works Employment Verification Act 127 of 2012.

Bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, or nation origin.

This project is funded in whole or part with federal funds. Davis-Bacon wage rates and other federal requirements apply and are included in the bid documents. Labor Compliance is mandatory.
